We are opening a temporary location medical clinic NOW!

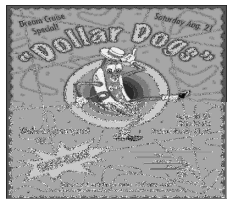

As time and resources allow, we will increase the number of open clinic hours and expand our services to those who have limited insurance, particularly those who do not have office visit coverage.**
