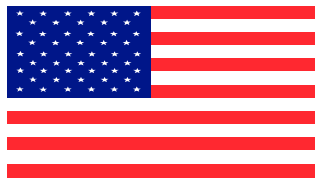
Altar Flowers

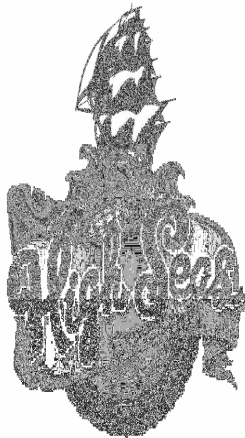

Rogers. Money collected will defray postage costs for cards Heidi sends to shut-ins on our behalf.

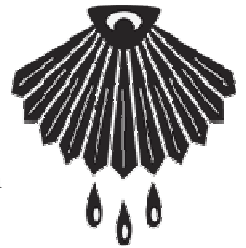
